Black played 1...Re3 and Britain's ninth Grandmaster was faced with mate by 2...Re1. White tried 2 g4 but after 2...fg3 he resigned since he was now faced with the threat of 3...Q:f3+.

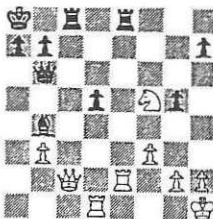
What should White have played?



Solution: Position No.2

Teschner-Portisch Monaco 1969
(klrlr3/pp5p/lq6/3p1Npl/1b6/1P3P2/2Q1R1PP/3R3K)

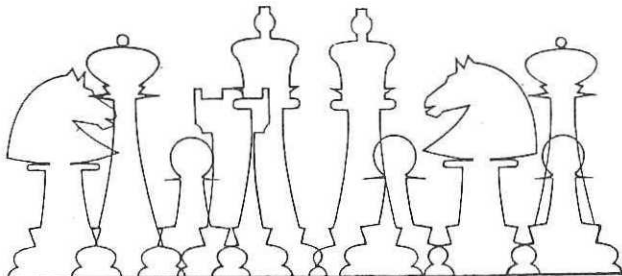
After 1 R:d5 Black can win by 1...Qf2! If 2 Ng3 then 2...Qe1+!

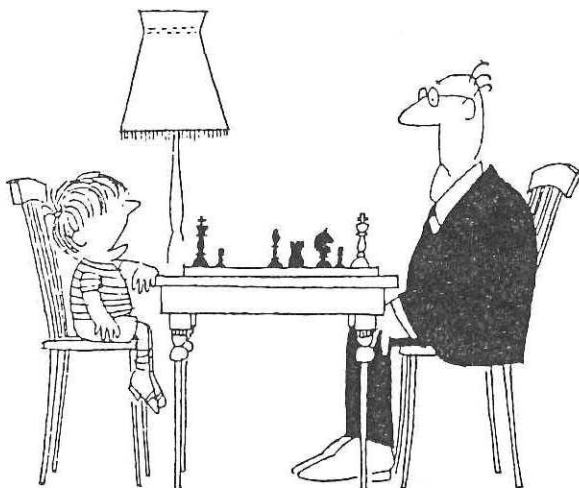
